

## CAMPS, LEAGUES, AND BASEBALL

The foundation hosts awesome Summer Camps! In addition to these valuable camps that give kids a chance, we also sponsor young people year-round in leagues and clinics with Cangelosi Baseball at Bo Jackson's Elite Sports Dome.

Currently the foundation sponsors 15 boys, ages 10-18, who participate in a variety of programs. With Cangelosi Baseball, they take advantage of programs that focus on different aspects of baseball. The Winter Hitting League takes place in November and December. This 8-week camp focuses on situational on-field hitting that allows a player to develop and understand his hitting approach.

Next up is the Holiday Bash for our younger players. It's a threeday holiday camp that focuses on both offensive and defensive play and cumulates in a total skills competition. And a pizza party of course! Four of our young men have qualified for the U-Dawgs Travel Team. Tryouts were held earlier this year and the players receive 24 weeks with Cangelosi Baseball as well as an annual dome membership. This is a tremendous opportunity and we are proud of our guys for making the team.

Cangelosi Baseball, founded by former Major League player John Cangelosi, is a premier baseball training group dedicated to fulfilling the needs of players of all ages and abilities. Their professional instruction and evaluation helps advance and develop a player's skill to the highest level.

The foundation's partnership with Cangelosi Baseball is one of the keys to the success of our program.

### **TUTORING OPPORTUNITIES**




